

**Flandreau Santee Sioux Tribal Health Center
Community Health Representative (CHR)**

SUMMARY: The Community Health Representative (CHR) provides eligible community members with transportation services for health care appointments, transportation assistance, preventative health education and in-home visits. Responsible for being a liaison between patients, family and health care providers to ensure patients understand their conditions and treatment and are receiving appropriate care.

QUALIFICATIONS: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Candidates with one to two (1-2) years previous patient care experience or certification as a Nursing Assistant, preferred. Minimum qualification:

- **Must have a valid driver's license and clean MVR**
- **High school diploma or GED required**
- **Must submit and pass pre-employment drug and alcohol testing**
- **Must submit to background investigation in accordance with Public Law 101-630, title IV, Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act of 1990.**
- **Ability to work with wheelchairs and assistive devices**
- **Knowledge of first aid and willing to get CPR certified.**
- **Must be able to lift 50lbs and know the proper techniques for lifting patients.**
