Candidates with one to two (1-2) years previous patient care experience or certification as a Nursing Assistant, preferred. Minimum qualification:

- Must have a valid driver's license and clean MVR
- High school diploma or GED required
- Must submit and pass pre-employment drug and alcohol testing
- Must submit to background investigation in accordance with Public Law 101-630, title IV, Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act of 1990.
- Ability to work with wheelchairs and assistive devices
- Knowledge of first aid and willing to get CPR certified.
- Must be able to lift 50lbs and know the proper techniques for lifting patients.
