An all night wake will be held on Wednesday, April 5th beginning at 7:00 P.M. at The Eastman Hall in Flandreau, South Dakota.

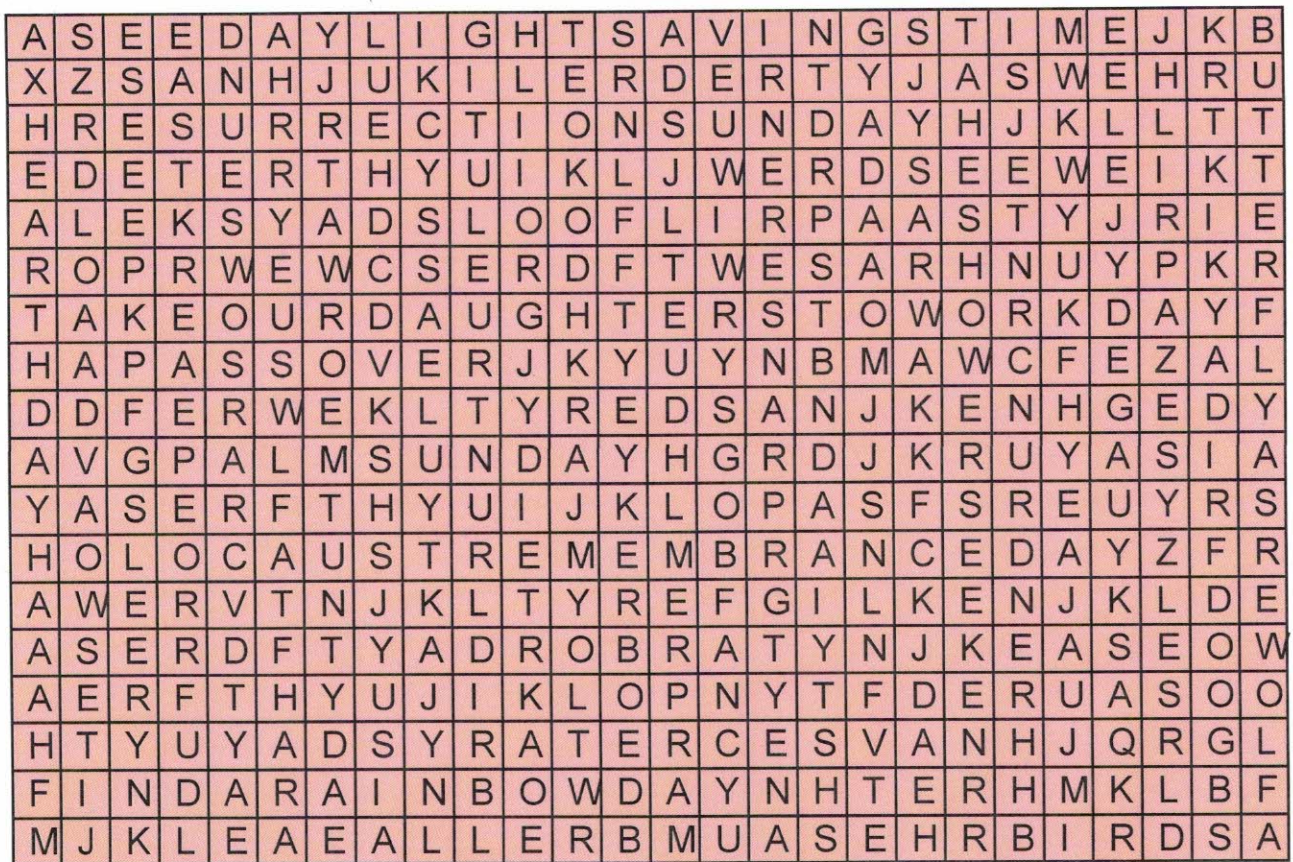

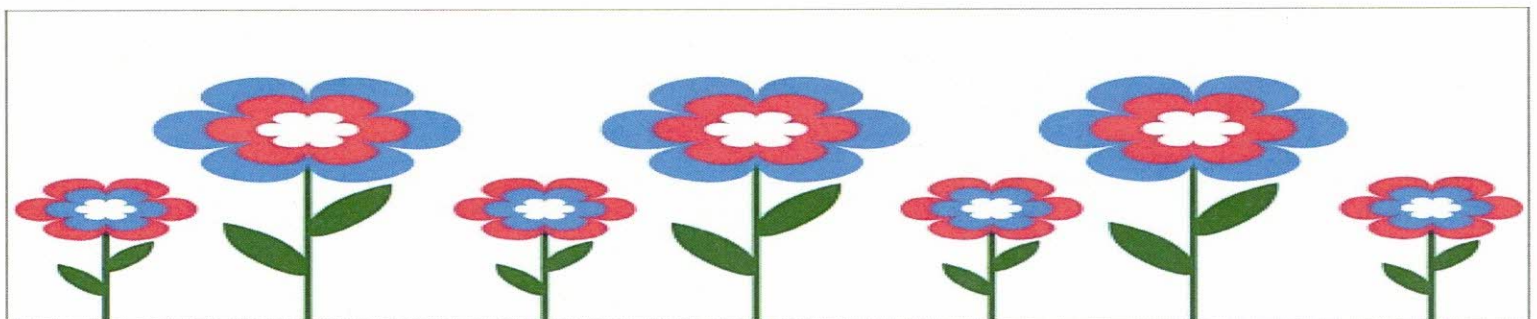
