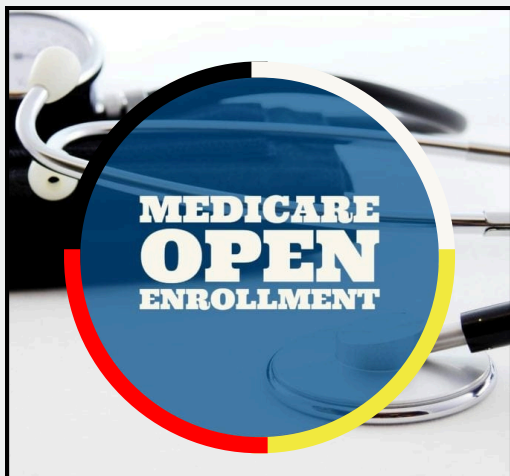


Flandreau Santee Sioux Tribal Health Center
