# Job Summary:

As Charge Nurse you are to provide direct nursing care to the residents and supervise the day-to-day nursing activities performed by the certified nursing assistants. This position also assists the Director of Nursing in planning, organizing, developing, and directing the day-to-day functions of the Nursing department in accordance with current federal, state, and local standards, guidelines, and regulations that govern our facility.

### Education

 Must possess a Nursing Degree from an accredited college or university and possess an active SD nursing license.

# **Specific Requirements**

- Must be able to pass a P.L. 101-630 character and criminal background check and pre-employment drug and alcohol testing.
- Must possess a current, unencumbered, active license to practice as a Registered Nurse in the State of South Dakota.
- Must be able to read, write, speak, and understand the English language.
- Must possess the ability to make independent decisions when circumstances warrant such action.
- Must possess the ability to deal tactfully with personnel, residents, family members, visitors, government agencies/personnel, and the general public.
- Must be knowledgeable of nursing and medical practices and procedures, as well as laws, regulations, and guidelines that pertain to long-term care.
- Must possess leadership and supervisory ability and the willingness to work harmoniously with professional and non-professional personnel.

Verification must be submitted with the application if claiming Indian Preference. Consideration will be given to non-Indian applicants in the absence of qualified Indian Preference eligible.
